

Frequently Asked Questions - Shinzen Garden

1. What are the hours of operation for Shinzen Garden?

Shinzen Garden is open 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM daily from October 1- March 31 and 10:00 AM to 7:00 PM from April 1- September 30, though hours may vary during holidays or special events. Please check our website or contact us for up-to-date information.

2. Is there an admission fee?

Yes, there is an admission fee to enter Shinzen Garden. We offer discounted rates for children, students, seniors, and families of 2-5 people. For specific pricing, please visit our Admissions page or contact us directly.

3. Are dogs allowed in the garden?

Dogs are not allowed in Shinzen Garden, with the exception of trained service animals. This policy ensures a peaceful experience for all visitors.

4. Can I bring food or drinks into the garden?

Outside food and drinks are not permitted in the garden, except for bottled water. We ask that you respect this policy to maintain a clean and tranquil environment.

5. Is there parking available in the garden?

Yes, there is ample parking available near the garden entrance. Parking is \$5 per car and may be paid via the City of Fresno kiosks in the parking area.

6. Are there any guided tours available?
